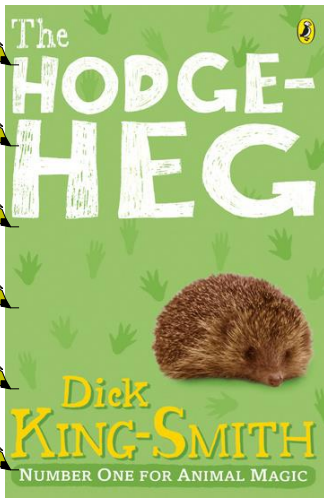

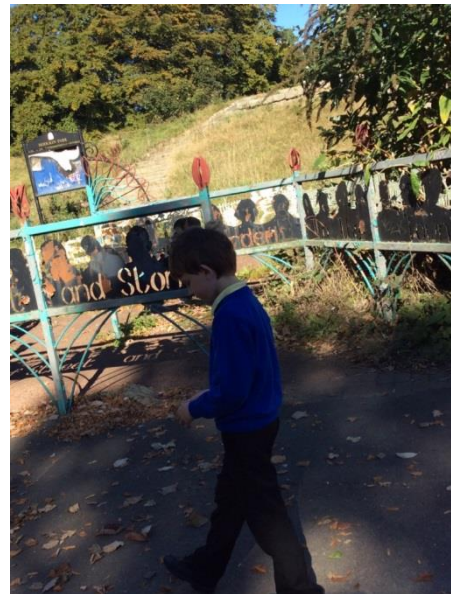
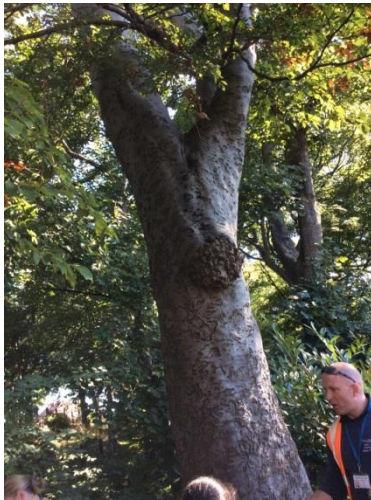


The Hodgeheg

The fire engine came and it came from Newcastle because Gateshead thought they didn't need a fire engine. But just one fire engine couldn't put out a fire. They got firemen from Sunderland, Hexham and Durham, Berwick and Carlisle.



People were trapped on the bridge as they had nowhere to go. 53 people died and explosions were heard 20 miles away. The stones were thrown 1200 metres. The fire lasted for

a day and a half.

Finally the firemen came and put out the fire it was called a fire break they pulled all the buildings that were seriously damaged down.

French

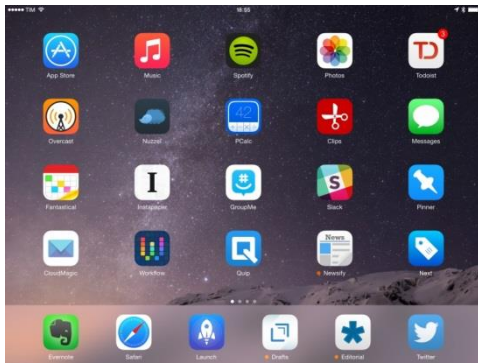
On Tuesday we do French and we learn a lot so if we go to France we all know what to say, like bonjour , which means hello.

Enterprise Week



On the 22nd march the dolphins class had their class assembly. It was great fun because everyone knew what they had to say and we were all sensible. The assembly was about things we did throughout the year.

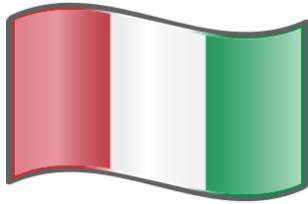
We had a play it was about electricity. There was a girl called little Miss Safe and she visited other people's houses and something bad was happening and then we explained why it was dangerous`.


