
In May it was enterprise week throughout school. It was the week that we were doing our test papers but we still had a couple of visitors and we went to KS2's enterprise fair which was great fun.




















Carol drew this amazing picture of the statue of Charles Grey to show us what he looks like on the top of Grey's Monument.
