What is the Bible?

- The Bible is split into two parts the Old Testament and the New Testament.
- The Old Testament was written before Jesus was born.
- The New Testament was written after he was born.
- It contains lots of different stories that Christians read and believe it gives them guidance in life.
- Some of the stories are called parables which are special stories Jesus taught with a moral attached to them.

Stories from the Bible

Moral- the meaning or message behind a story (e.g. the boy who cried wolf)

Darius- a famous King in the Old Testament part of the Bible.

Daniel- a man who helped the king.

Jealous- wishing you had something or could do something someone else has or does.

Parable- a special story told by Jesus with a hidden message behind it.

Scatter- spread out across the ground.

Thorny- prickly and pointy twigs or bushes (e.g. like thorns on a rose bush)

Testament- the name given to two separate parts of the Bible.
