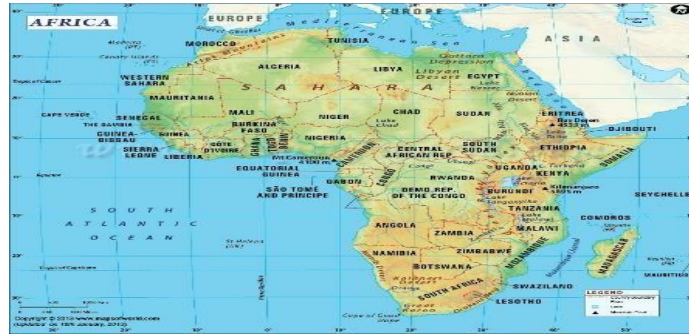


# Year 1 - Where in the World? Amazing Africa

## Subject Specific Vocabulary

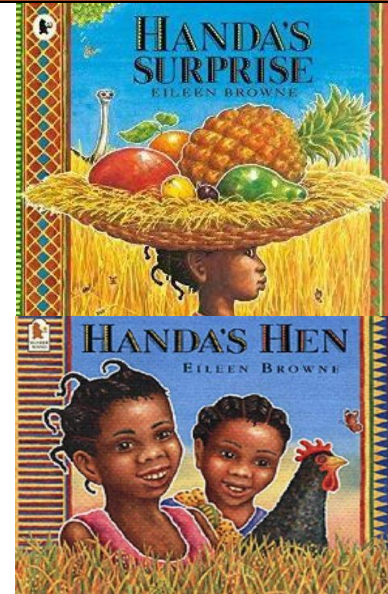
<b>Africa</b>	A continent made up of 54 countries.
<b>Kenya</b>	A large country found in East Africa.
<b>Globe</b>	A ball/Sphere with a map of the world.
<b>Atlas</b>	A book of maps.
<b>city</b>	A place with many streets and buildings where people live and work. A city is larger than a town or village.
<b>village</b>	A group of houses in a country area.
<b>map</b>	A drawing of a town, a country or the world.
<b>Country</b>	A land with its own people and laws.
<b>Continent</b>	One of the 7 very large areas of land in the world.
<b>Equator</b>	An imaginary line around the middle of the earth. Countries near the equator are very hot



## Key Facts

<b>The weather around the world is not all the same. It changes depending on where you live in the world and the season.</b>
<b>The equator is an imaginary line around the middle of the earth. Countries near the equator are very hot, countries far away for example the North pole and South pole are very cold.</b>
<b>Globes and atlases help us to find countries and continents in the world.</b>
<b>Hot and cold countries can look very different and have different physical features. Different things will grow, animals and people will do different activities depending on the weather.</b>
<b>In the Uk we have 4 seasons, the weather is warmer in the summer and cold in the winter. Different things happen at different times of the year.</b>
