- $\ \square$ Hinduism is one of the world's major religions. It is the world's 3rd largest religion with about 1.1 billion followers. It is around 5,000 years old.
- Hindus are the people who follow Hinduism.
- Many Gods are worshipped in Hinduism. All of these different Gods are believed to be a part of the supreme God named 'Brahman'.
- Hindus believe in Karma and reincarnation that when you die you are reborn as something else.
- Hinduism does not have one holy book, but several sacred texts. Mandirs are Hindu worship buildings.

Where and how do Hindus worship? Why?	 Many Hindus worship at home in their own shrine—this could be anything from a room, an altar or simply pictures or statues. The Hindu temple is called a Mandir. At Mandirs, Hindu people often recite the names of Gods and Goddesses. They also offer water, fruit and flowers to the Gods. This is known as puja. 	
Who do they believe in?	 Hindus believe in one supreme God called Brahman. He can be found in everyone and everything, including the other Gods. Some of the important other Gods include 'Brahma' (the creator), 'Shiva', (the destroyer) and 'Vishnu' (the protector). These three form the 'Trimurti' (trinity). 	
Who is Lakshmi?	Lakshmi is the goddess of money and good luck in Hinduism. She is the wife of the Hindu god Vishnu. Most Hindus pray to her on Diwali, which is a festival in India. Lakshmi has four arms, fair skin and sits on a lotus flower and is normally surrounded by elephants. She is covered in jewellery.	
What is Om or Aum?	Om or Aum is a sacred symbol that represents Brahman.	Si
