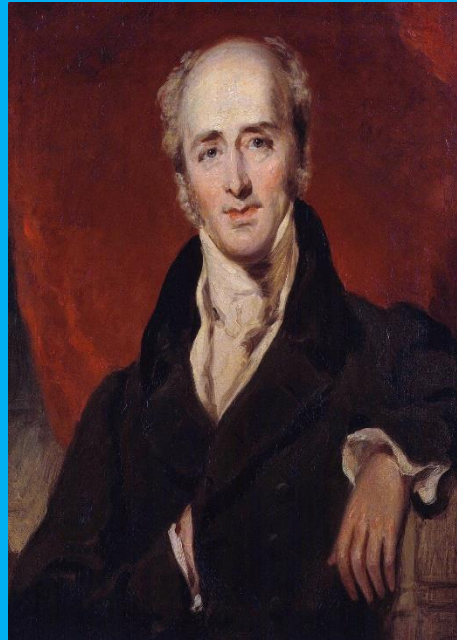


Year 1 - History - Charles Grey

Key Vocabulary

Monument - a statue that is built in memory of a person.

Charles Grey was born 13th March 1764 in Northumberland. He became Prime minister of the United Kingdom from 22 November 1830 to 16th July 1834.

He married Elizabeth Ponsonby and they had 16 children.

Charles died on the 16th July 1845 age 81.
