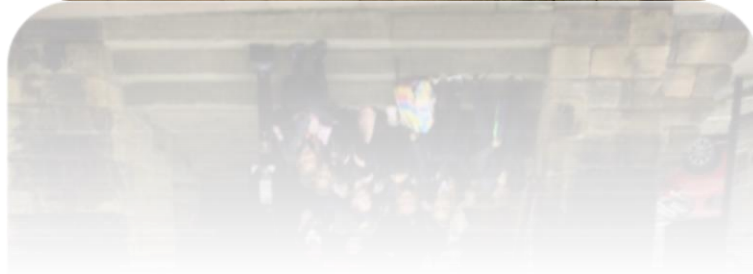


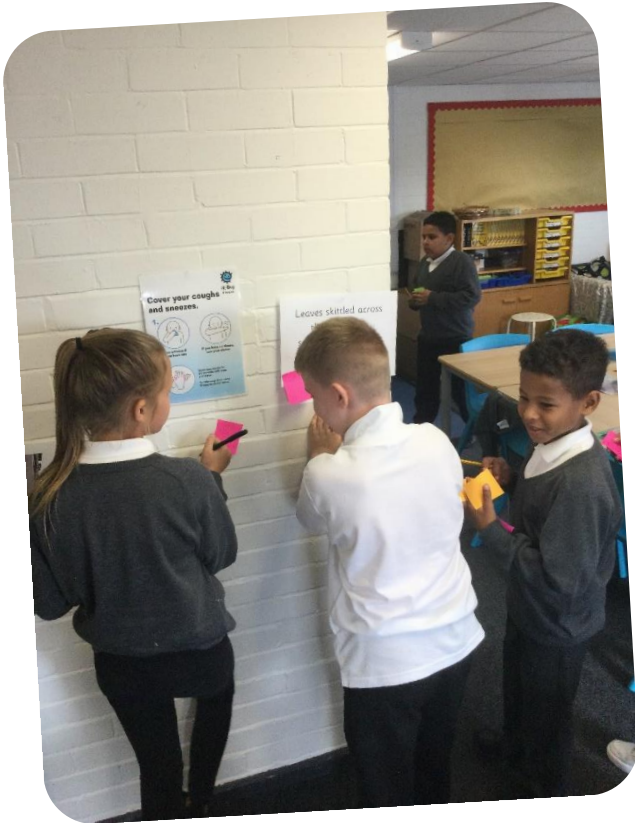
What is the significance of The Newcastle Keep to Newcastle City?

During our Topic lessons this term, we have been learning about Crime and Punishment through the ages and have been reading a class novel called,

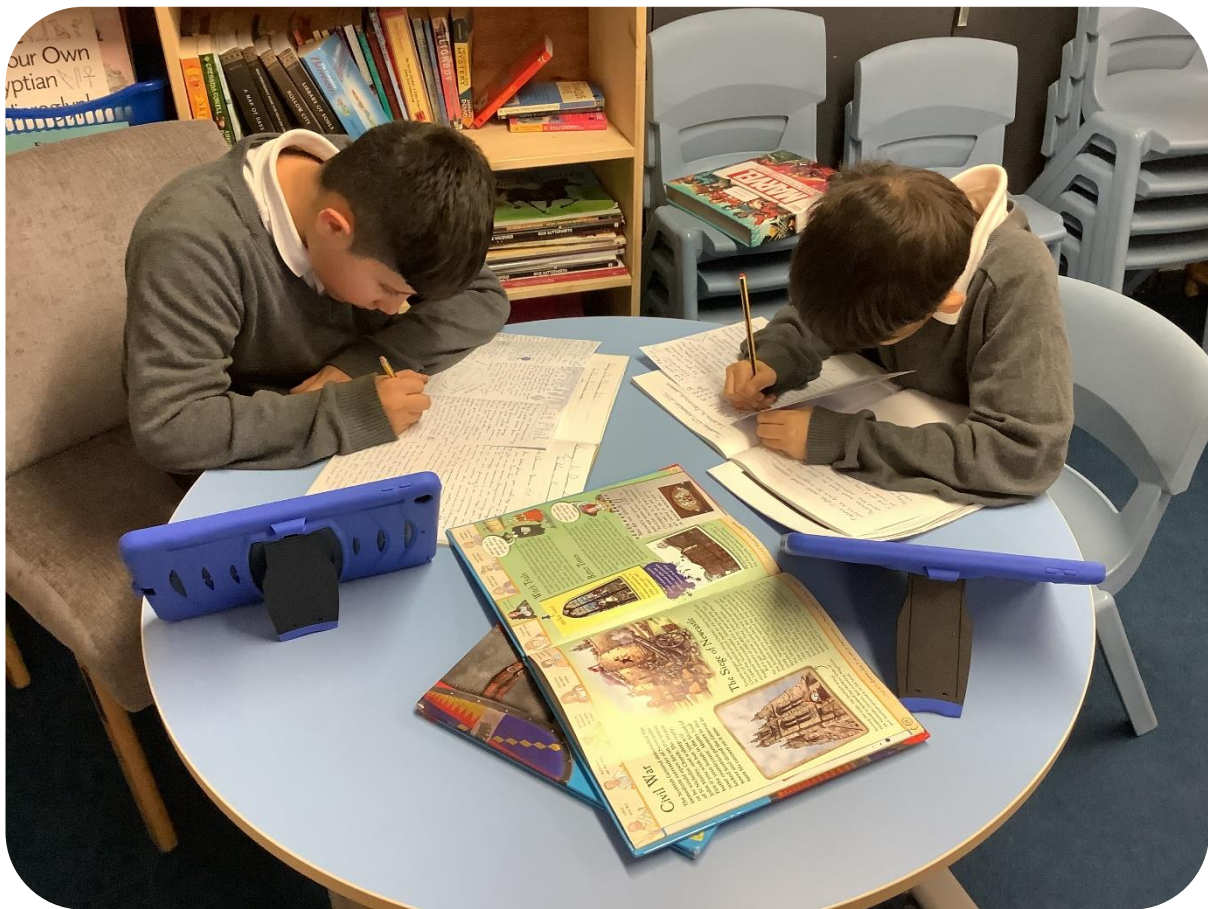
‘Walking with Witches’ in English. The Castle Keep features in this novel and so our investigation began with



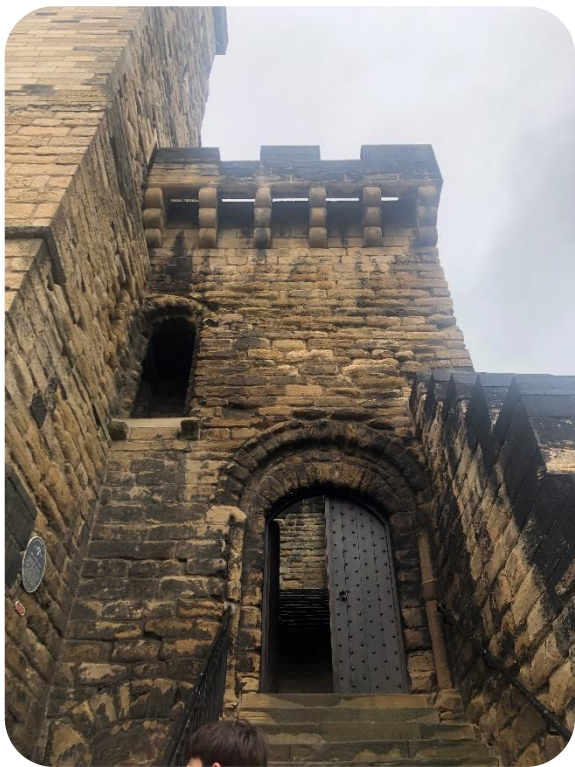
our enquiry based learning.
