

We had a selection of information books, magazines and newspaper articles from Dorothy, which are all about the life of Queen Elizabeth II and her family.

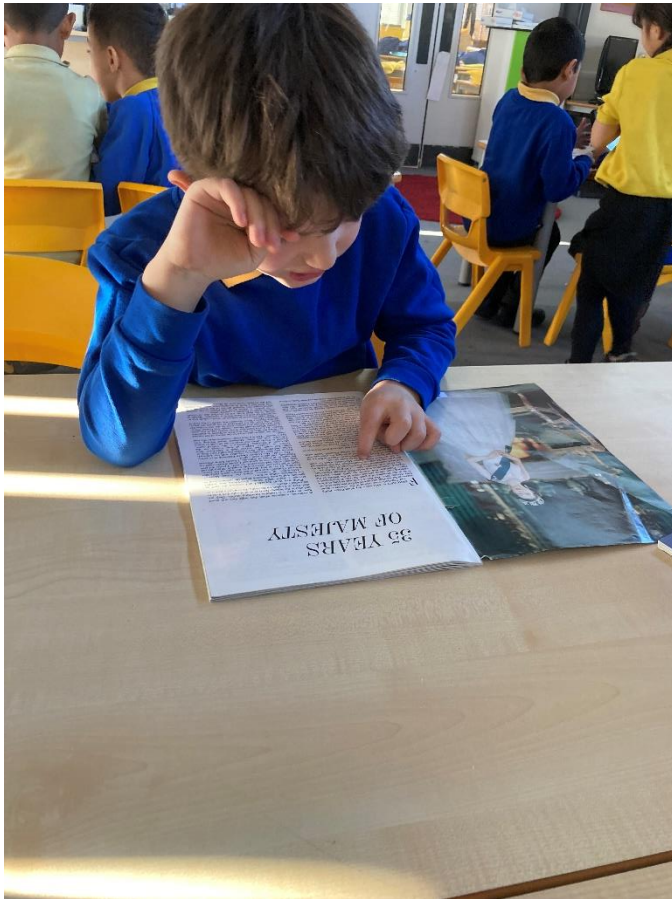


There is a lot of information about the Queen. We enjoyed learning about her coronation and how she became Queen.

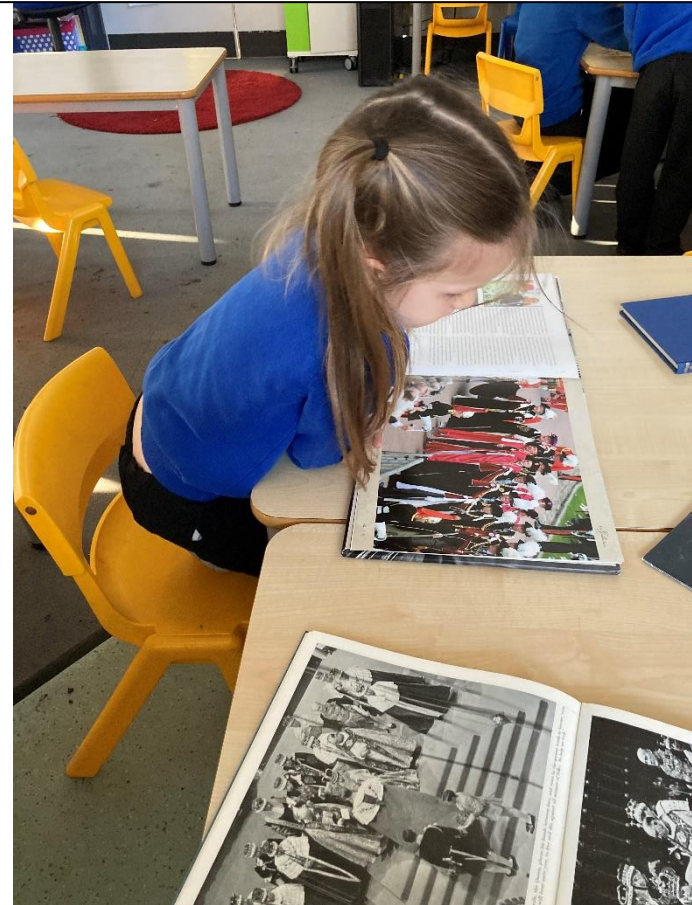
Zak said it was strange looking at pictures in black and white.

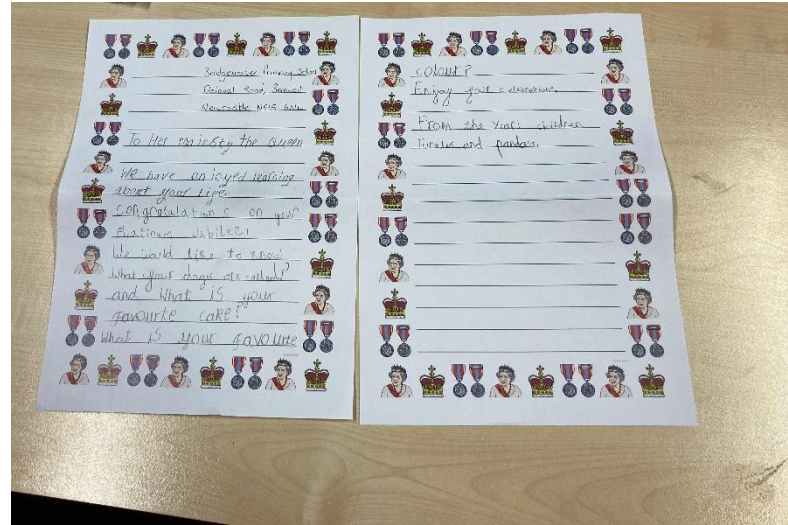
We talked about the Queen's jubilee and we had a tea party to celebrate.

We took our letter down to Miss Whelan who has a special machine that puts stamps on envelopes.

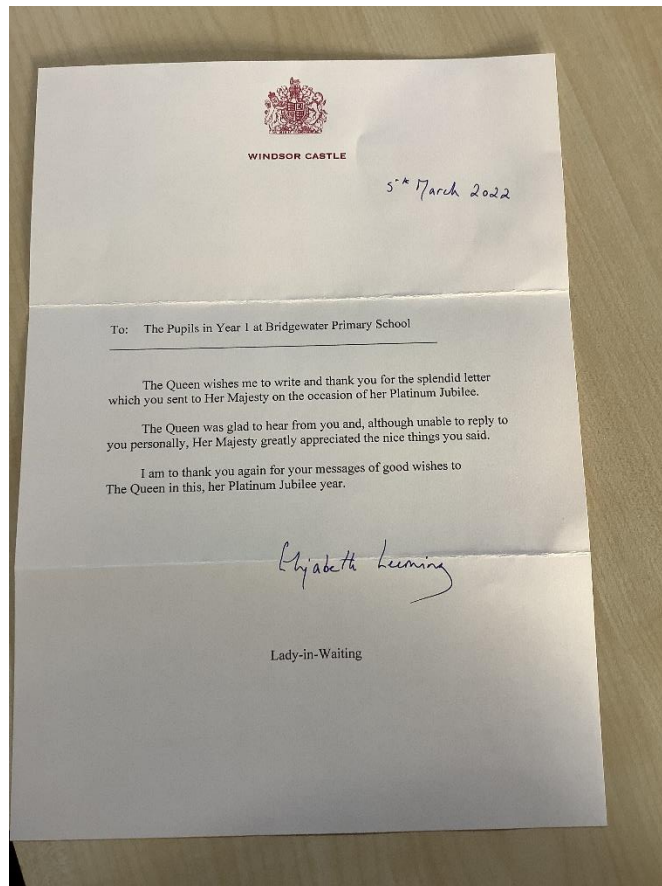


Miss Whelan showed us the special stamp machine and we watched while she put a stamp on our letter.

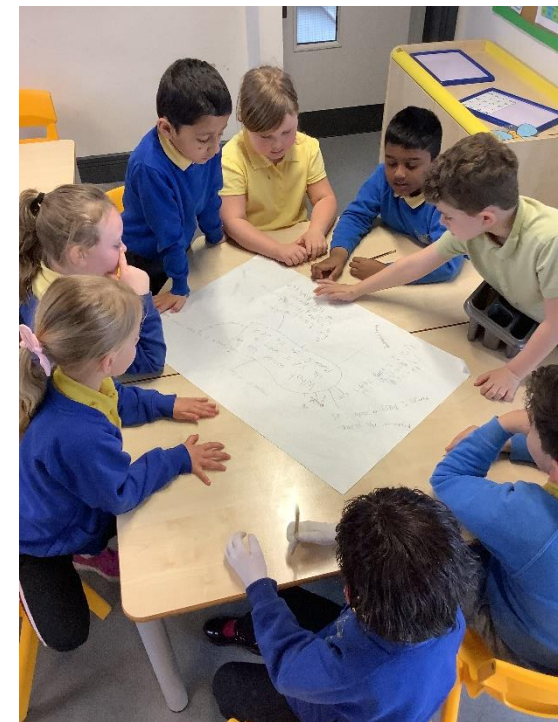
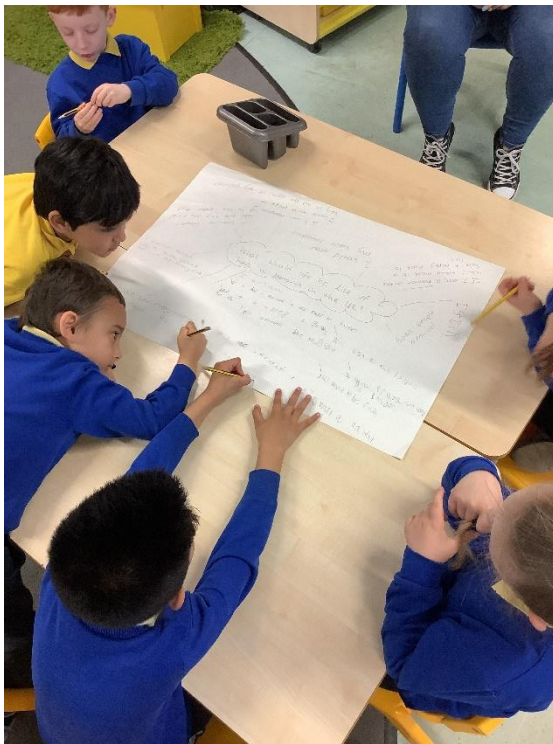
The letter will go in the post-box for the postman to take to Buckingham palace.



We received a letter from Windsor castle.

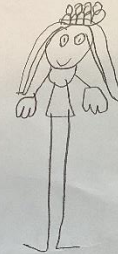


We worked in groups to discuss what life would be like if we were a Monarch in the United Kingdom. They discussed how they would make the UK a happier place to live and how they would do it.
