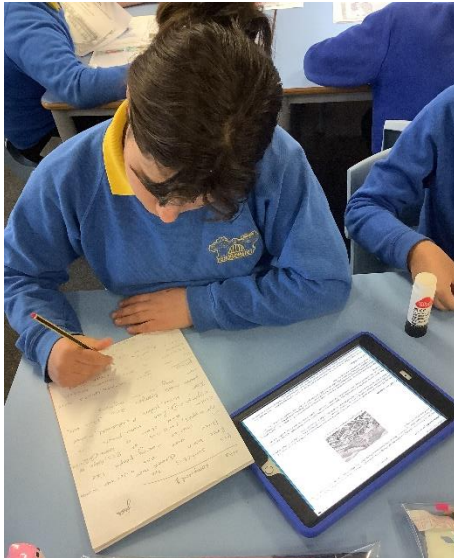
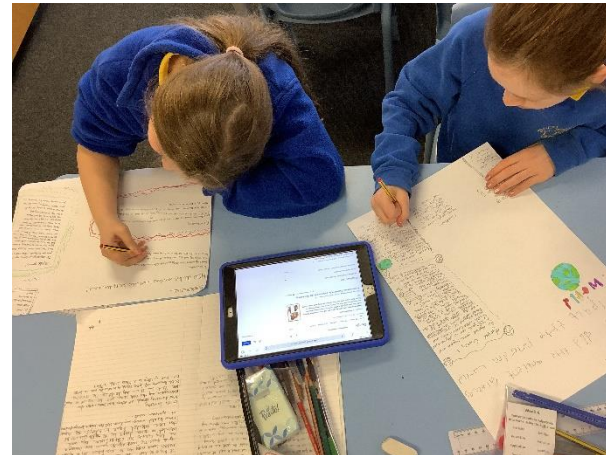
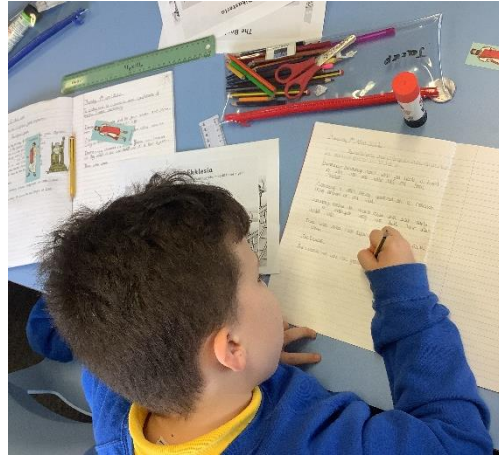


How did the ancient Greeks impact the modern world?

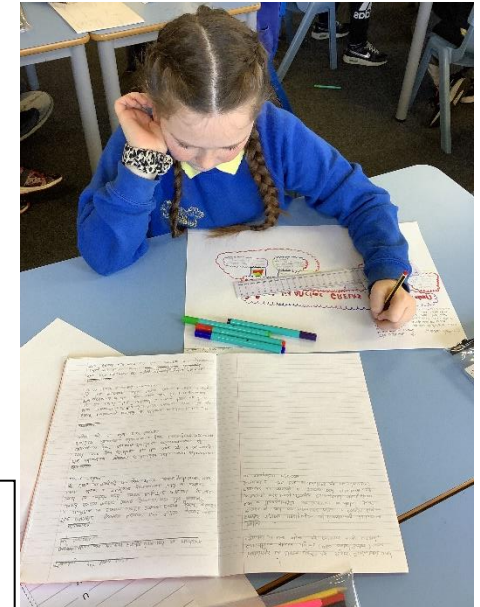

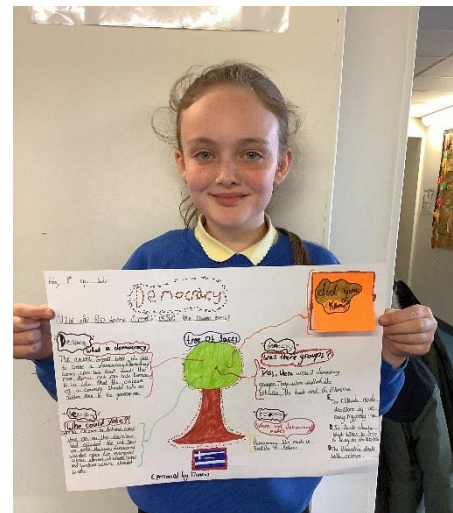
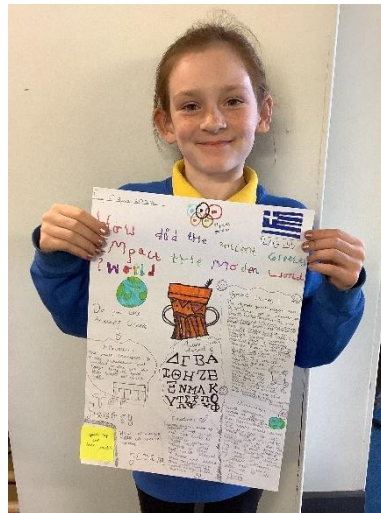
Children researched their own information about the Olympics and gathered further questions from their research.



As a class we looked at democracy in ancient Athens, who was involved, and who was excluded. We compared this to modern day democracy within the UK. We even tried some voting within our classroom.



We worked in groups and individually researched an area of choice that influenced today's modern world sharing our information with each other in discussions. We then created information posters to share what we had learnt.



The children shared their enquiry learning in the form of an information poster and presented their findings to the rest of the class sharing their knowledge to answer the question 'How did the ancient Greeks impact the modern world?'
