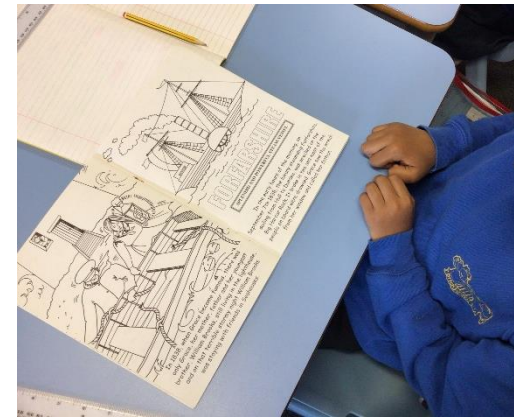
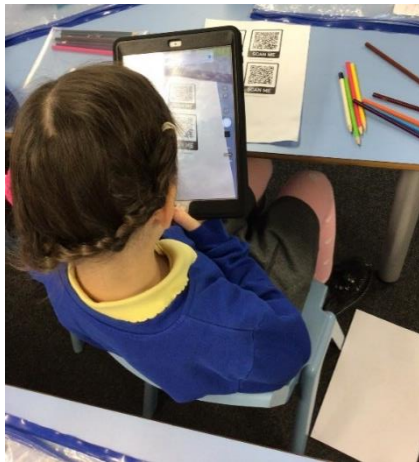


Year 2 Seals - Enquiry based learning - Summer 2022.

We visited the Grace Darling Museum in Bamburgh to find out more about Grace's life, her rescue and the impact of her life on sea rescue today.



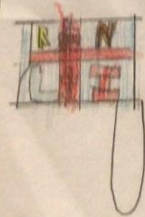
Presenting our research and our end products

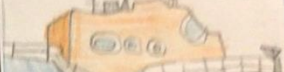
RNLI Saving lives at sea

RNLI is a charity. RNLI sends Royal National Lifeboat Institution. Life guards and lifeboat crew want to reach everyone in time. to preventing drowning. Life guards and lifeboat crew work 24 hours a day and 365 days a year. The RNLI have been saving lives for nearly 200 years. 142,000 lives have been saved since 1824 by the RNLI. RNLI take risks to save people in the sea.

RNLI Lifeboats



The RNLI uses a lot of lifeboats to save people that are in danger from the sea. The first on is the all weather life boat when it falls over it turns back over again in the water. The all weather life boat can't go into cover, cliffs and not reach rocks. The all weather life boat can go in all weather.



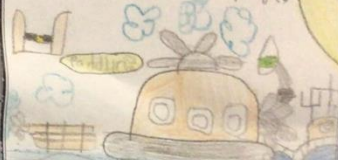
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Grace Darling Rescue



On the 26th of September 1838 the steamship Forth White dashed into the Bigg's Hark at rock and it was a stormy night. Grace Darling was looking through her telescope in the lighthouse when she saw the boat that dashed. She told her father and they went out in the storm. They had no special equipment and no dedicated lifeboats and their only boat was a big cable when they went in the lighthouse they saved 9 people.

How have sea rescues changed



Since 1838 sea rescues have changed a lot. RNLI is a dedicated charity that saves lives at sea. In 1838 Grace Darling didn't have any safe lifeboats or any special equipment like life jackets and paddling boats. She only had a wooden boat that was called a cable. Lifeboats have engines but in 1838 they didn't have that because it was a really long time ago and not like today.
