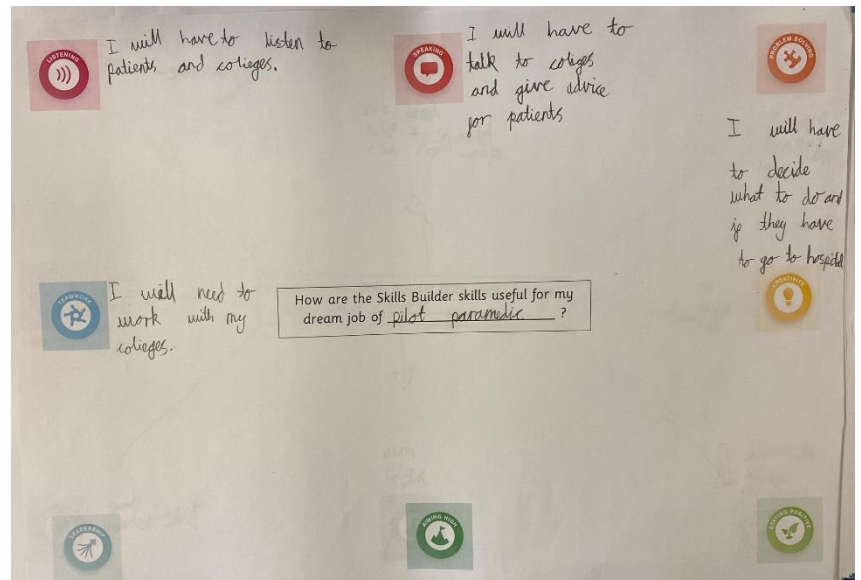


# What skills do I need for my dream job?

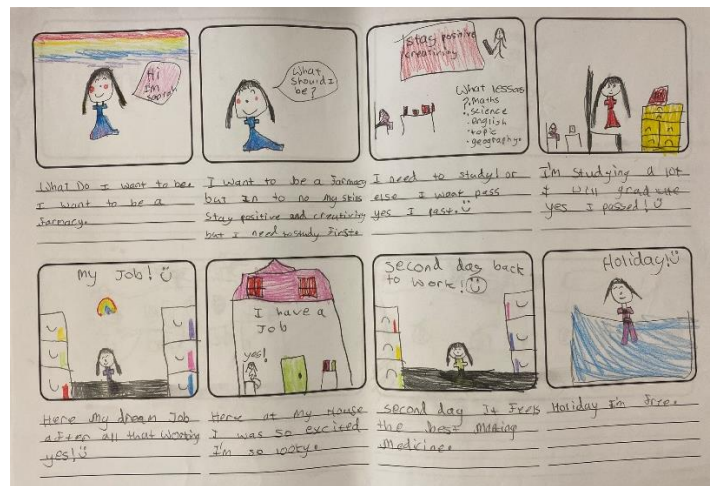
