




"How have North East schools changed since the times of Queen Victoria? At the start of the project we revisited what we had learnt about Queen Victoria in Autumn 1.

Next we used videos and images on the iPads to solidify what we had learnt.




Later, we used QR codes with preprogramed webpages to find out about the teachers in Victorian schools
