

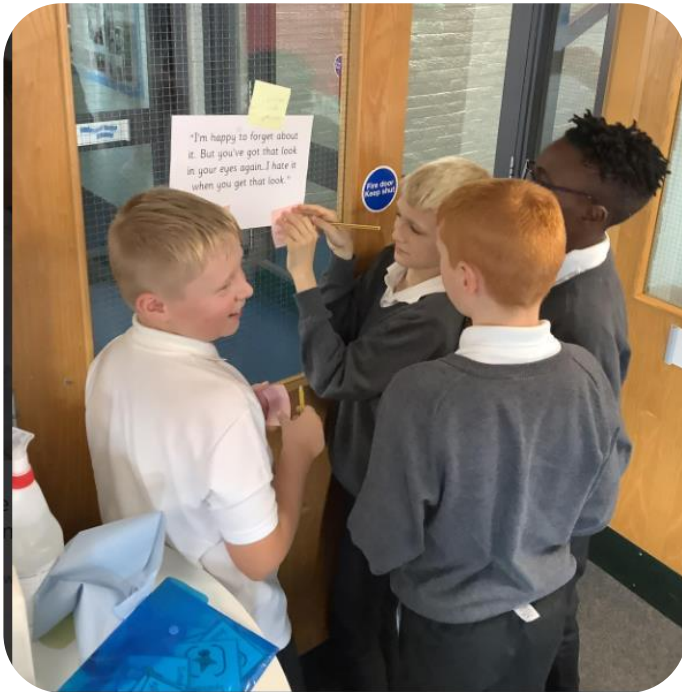
What is the significance of The Newcastle Keep to Newcastle City?

with our enquiry based learning.

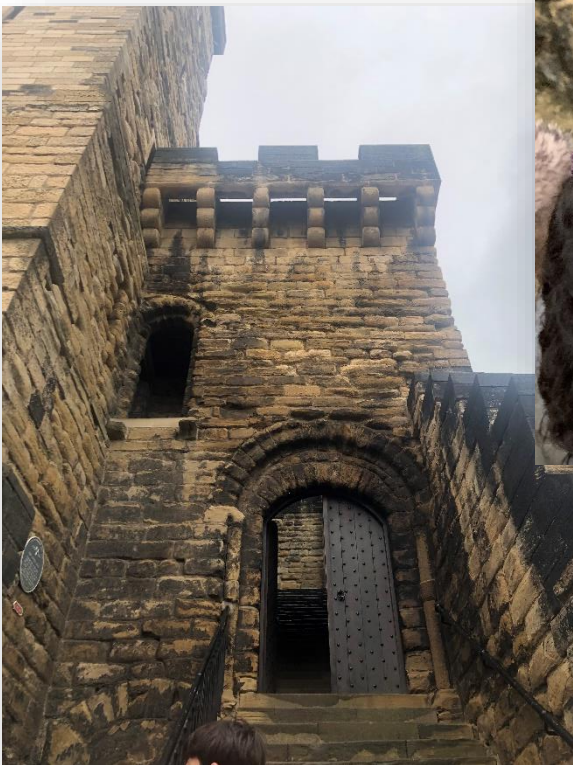
We carried out our own research on the significance of The Castle Keep. We used books, information leaflets and the internet to help us
