

We began our journey by finding out what prior knowledge our children have on travel and transport. We then explored the different ways our friends travel to school. We collected the data by producing a tally chart.







How do we travel to school?


Once we had developed a good understanding of travel and transport we read a variety of different stories

We categorised transport into air, sea and land.








We explored some of the different ways we travel in and around school including using our balance bikes and tricycles.







We took part in an engineering project with our school. We sketched our design first which was a method of transport that we would later build with junk modelling.






We put our fantastic computing skills to good use and used the mouse to design different modes of transport.
