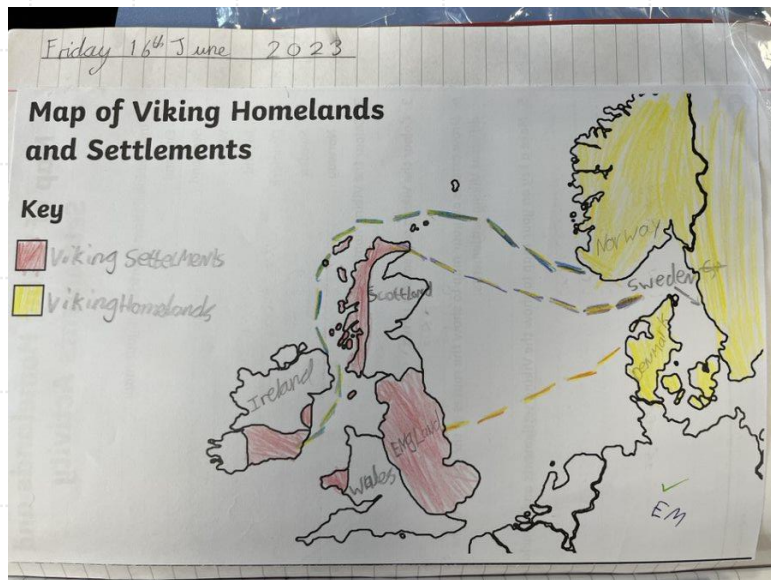


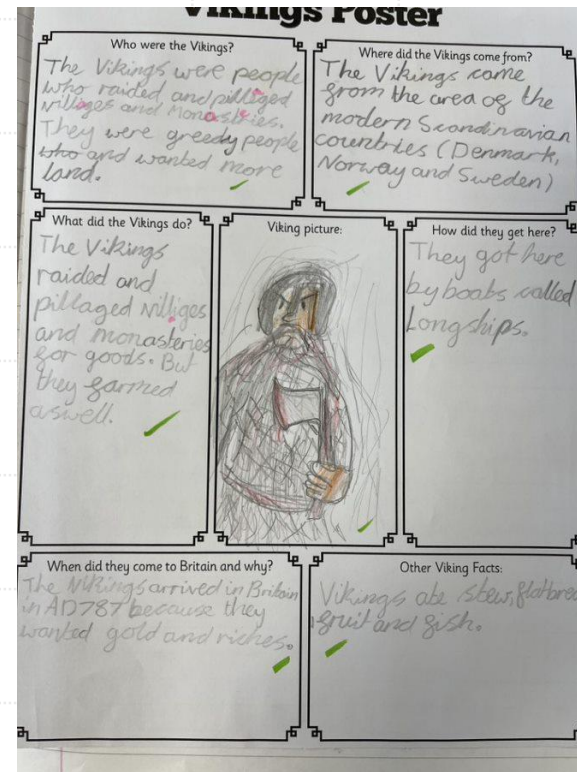

For all of the houses they would use natural resources like stone or wood, mud, straw and stick in the centre of the house there will be a fire place to keep warm.

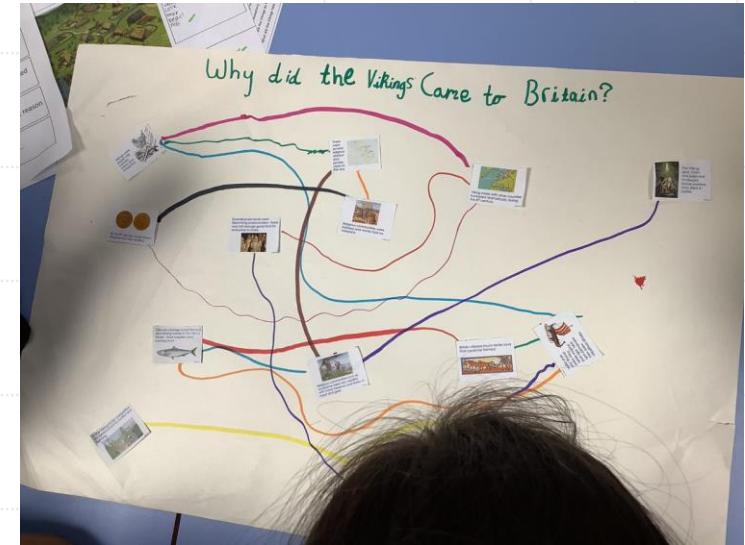


They didn't have knives and spoons. They drank beer because the water was not clean. They drank it out of horns. Even the children drank beer for the same reason. They get sick and over meat.




Job description (what would you have to do?): They would have to raid, kill, plunder and steal monasteries and monks. They would have to travel on a long ship.
