
To begin our learning, we used maps and other information sources to find out about the Vikings.





We thought about what the experience would have been like from the different perspectives of the Viking soldiers and of the monks who lived there.


We looked closely at a primary source to think about the claims we could make from it. We also began thinking about how reliable the source is.







We then thought about different aspects of Viking village life.
