

All Around the World (







The **Prime Meridian** is an imaginary line at 0° longitude.

It runs through Greenwich in London because the Royal Observatory was used as a major navigational base for ships at the time.

Time zones give the time at different places on Earth because it can be day and night at different times in different places.

There are 24 time zones across the world and they are measured in relation to the time at Greenwich.
