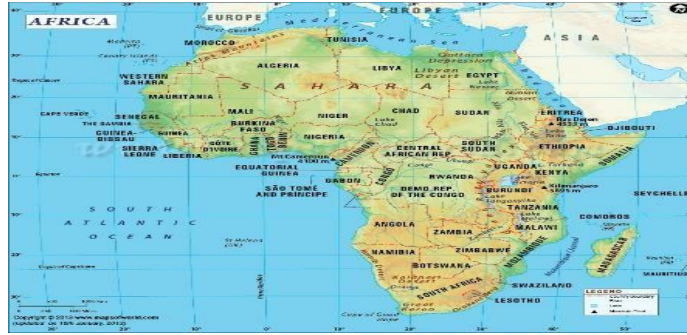


Year 1 - Where in the World? Amazing Africa

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Africa	A continent made up of 54 countries.
Globe	A ball/sphere with a map of the world.
Atlas	A book of maps or charts.
City	A place with many streets and buildings where people live and work.
Map	A map is an image of an area, usually of the Earth or part of the Earth.
Village	A group of houses in a country area.
Country	A land with its own people and laws.
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the earth. Countries near the equator are very hot.



Key Facts

The weather around the world is not all the same. It changes depending on where you live in the world and the season.
The equator is an imaginary line around the middle of the earth. Countries near the equator are very hot, countries far away for example the North pole and South pole are very cold.
Globes and atlases help us to find countries and continents in the world.
