How '**The Trinity**' is a **core Christian belief.**

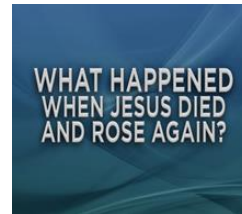
How and why Christians believe that **God is God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit** and yet **3 persons in 1 person**

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Trinity</b>	The Christian belief of God as being the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
<b>Resurrection</b>	When someone comes back to life.
<b>Holy Spirit</b>	A helper sent from God to help Christians connect with him and guide them in their daily lives.
<b>Loving father</b>	Christians see God as a loving father as well as God.
<b>Symbolism</b>	When an ideas, feeling, emotion or other concept is used to represent something else.
<b>Salvation</b>	To become ' <b>Right with God</b> ' again and remove any obstacles between a person and God.
<b>Consequences</b>	Something that happens when you behave in a particular manner.
<b>Forgiveness</b>	A decision to let go of negative feelings.
<b>Torah</b>	The Jewish holy book.
