Key Vocabulary

worship	Using words, thoughts and actions to communicate with God.
denomination	A group of people who belong to the same religion but may worship in a different way.
artefacts	Objects used in worship or to make the believer feel closer to God
restricted	To put a limit on what someone is allowed to do or not do.
expression	Ways of worshipping God either personally or with others.
tradition	A way of thinking, doing or behaving that has been passed down from one generation to another.
Religious freedom	Being permitted/ allowed to practice your religion without restrictions.
diversity	To embrace differences between peoples beliefs and traditions.
tolerance	To respect people who may have different beliefs to your own.
