
Meanings within Easter


We will be exploring and investigating?

Symbolic- where an image, object or idea is used to represent something else.

Literal-when something is emphasised as true.

Metaphor- a way of describing something by comparing it with something else that has some of the same qualities:

Multifaceted- to have lots of different sides, features, abilities, elements or parts.

Characteristics - to have a special quality and appearance different to others.

Significance - something that is important to an individual or group of people.
