<b>impressions</b>	A way of influencing or effecting someone or something.
<b>miracle</b>	An event caused by the power of God.
<b>blasphemous</b>	To show disrespect to God.
<b>persecuted</b>	To treat someone unfairly or cruelly.
<b>shepherd</b>	Jesus was seen as shepherd looking after his sheep (us).
<b>Pharisees</b>	Religious leaders.
<b>resurrected</b>	To be brought back from the dead.
<b>Symbolic language</b>	A way of communicating with a message or giving a visual picture of something.
