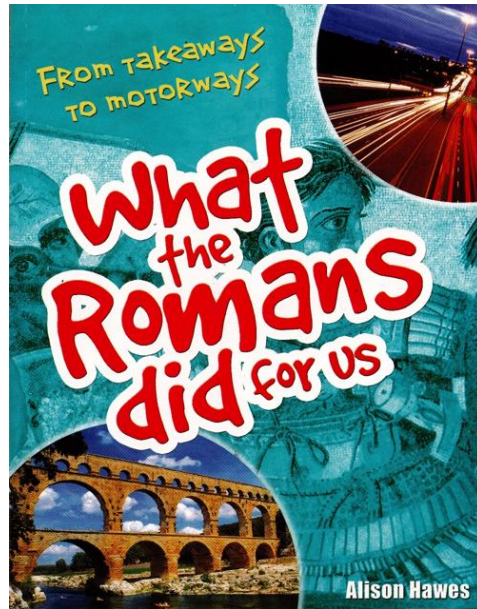


How did the Romans Influence Britain?

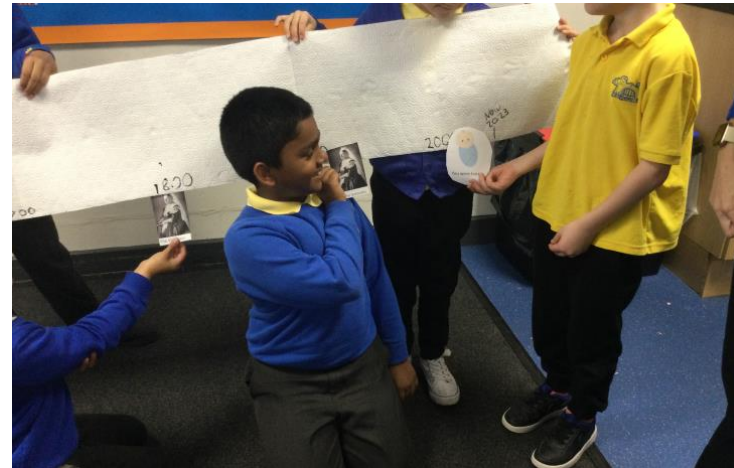
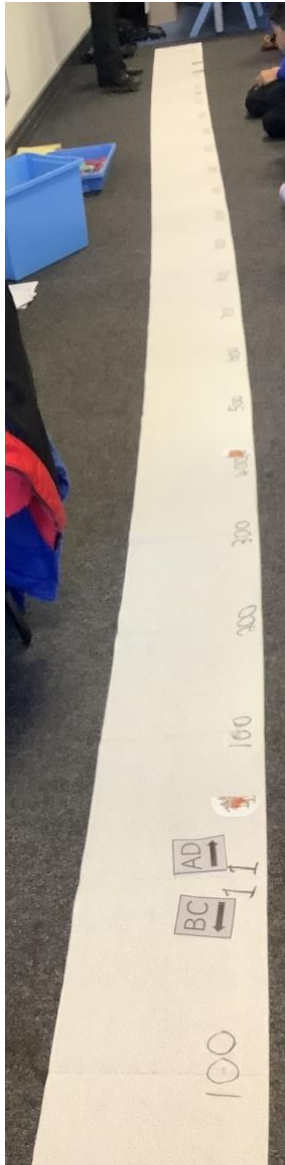

Timeline

We made a timeline out of kitchen roll. We placed Roman Britain on the timeline as well as other historical events and periods that we learned about in Year Two. We could see just how long ago Roman Britain was compared to the Victorian era!
