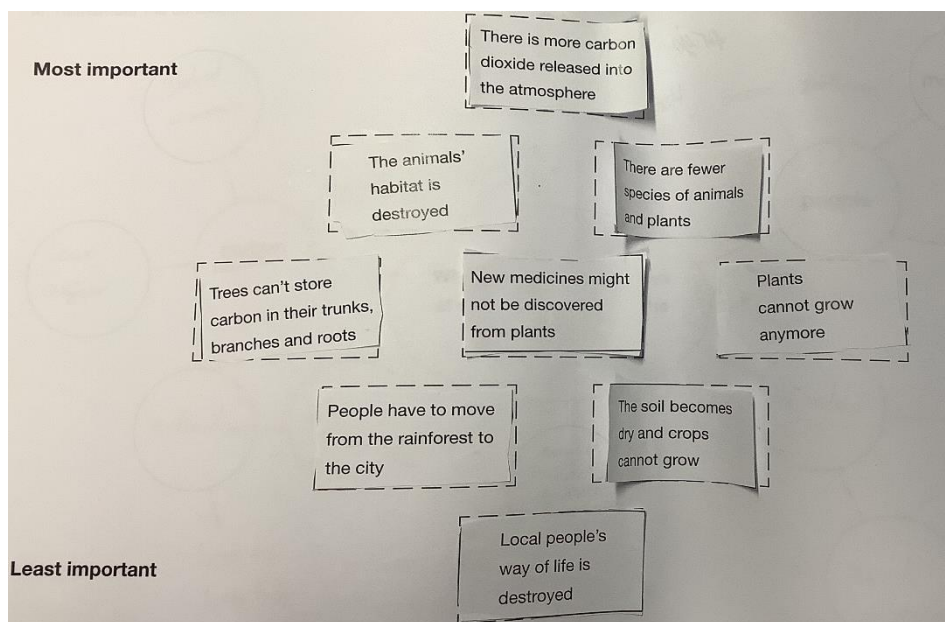
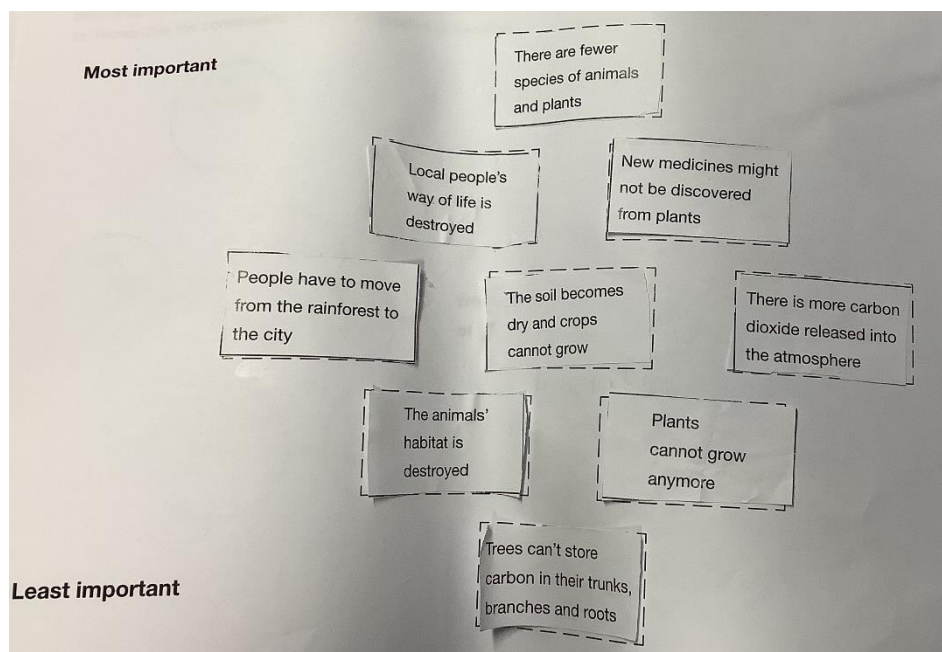


## What are the consequences if we do not stop deforestation?

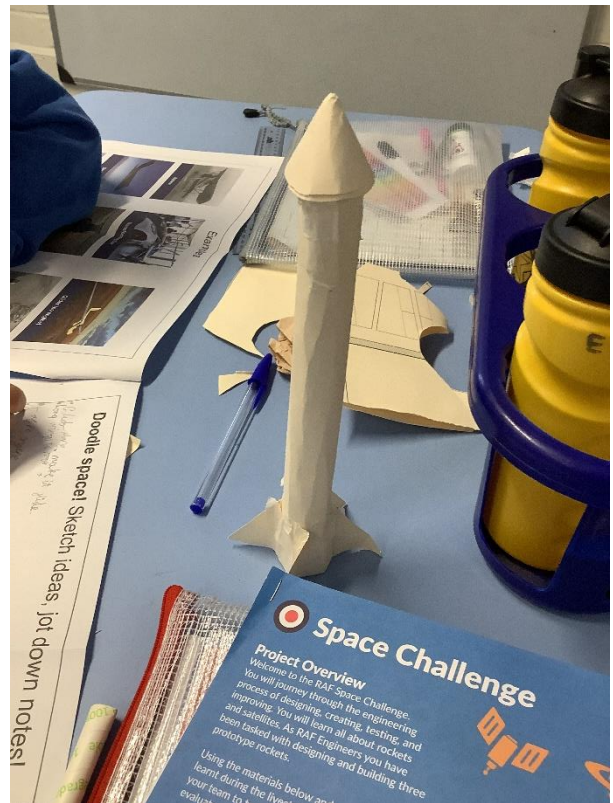
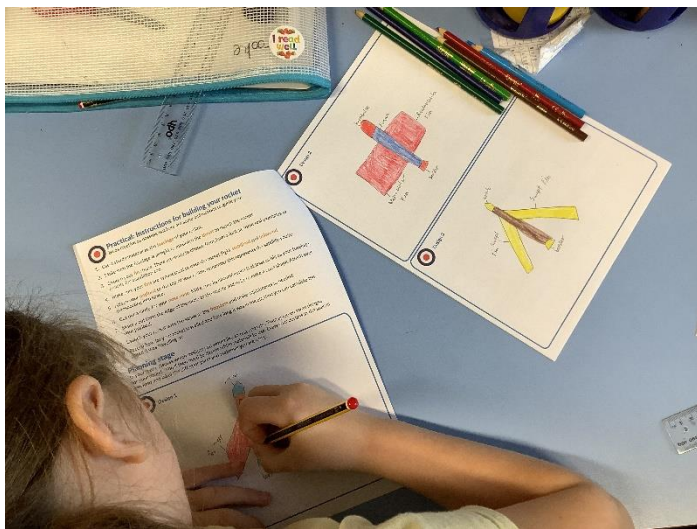
Last half term, in Geography we looked at the Amazon rainforest and how deforestation is very common in this area. We looked at what deforestation means and how this can affect people, animals and plants.

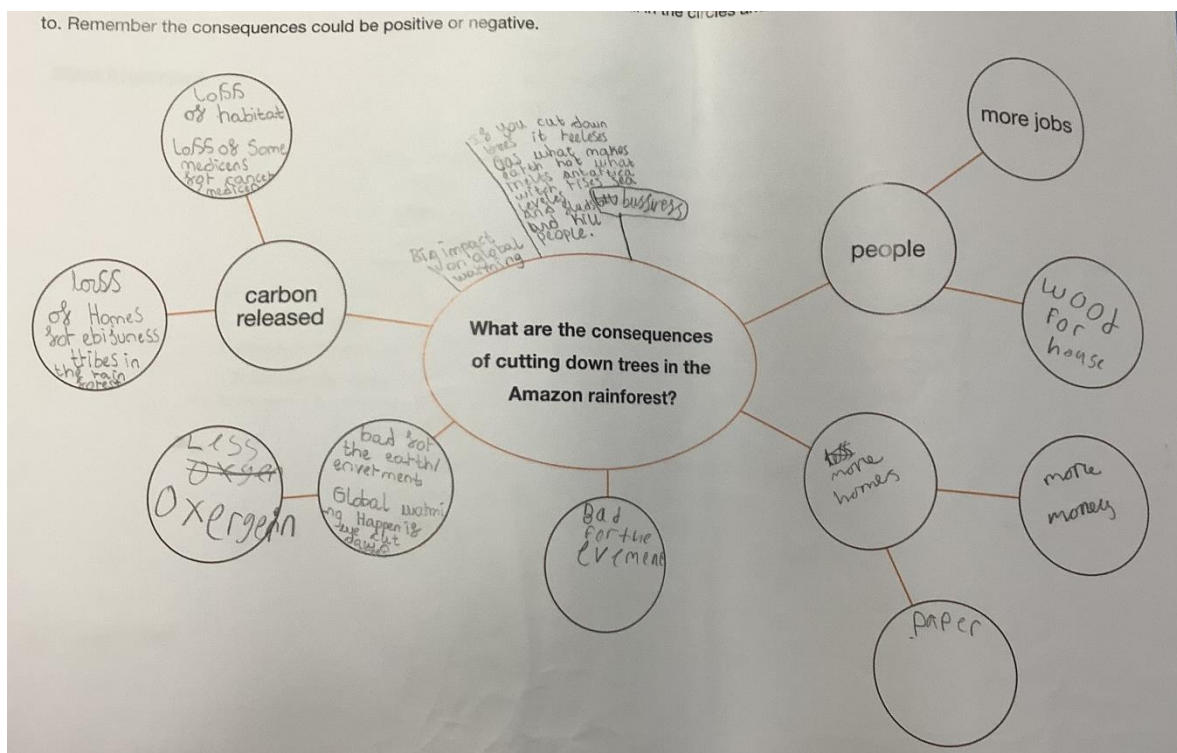


We looked at the impact on the economy and businesses and the job roles they create which bring money into the rainforest areas.

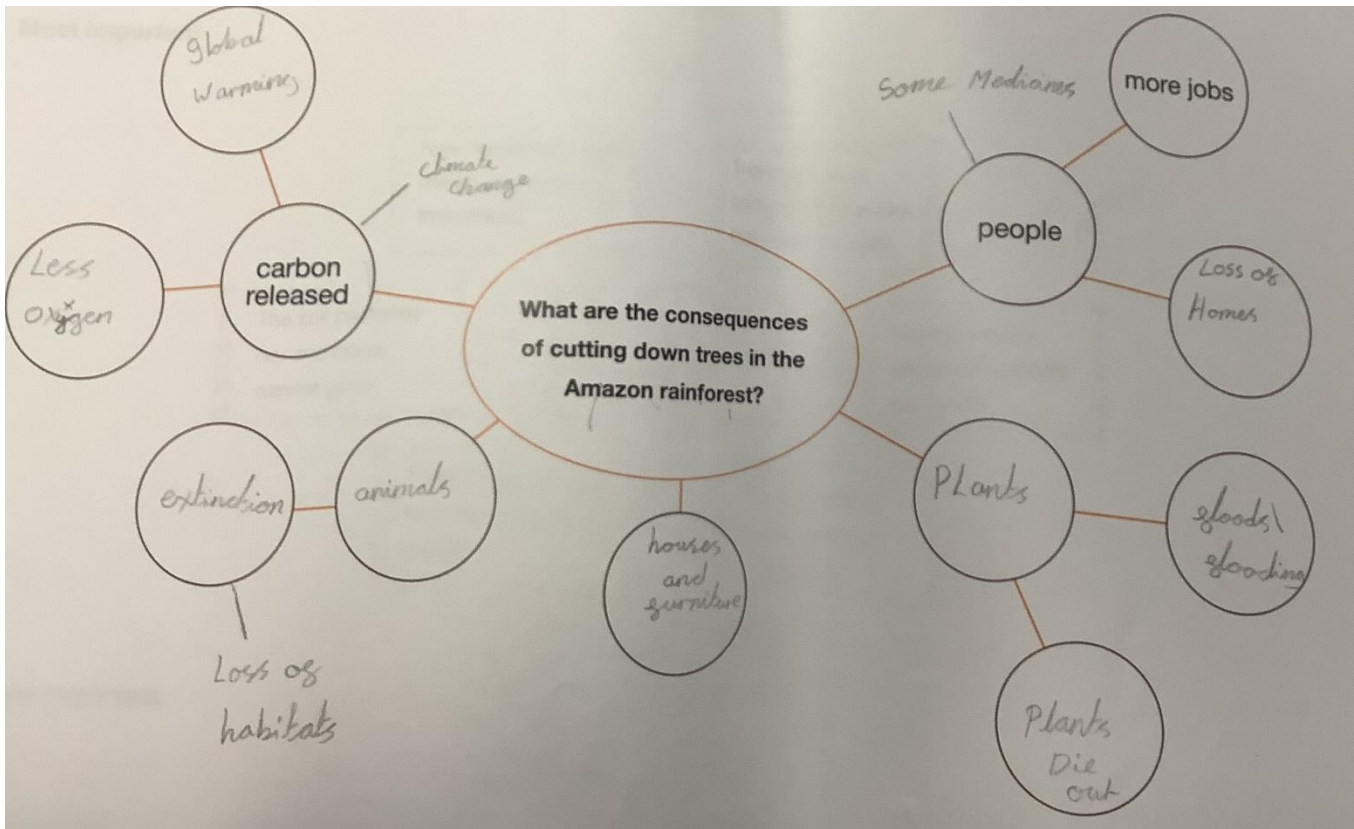
We took part in the 'Road to RIAT' STEM workshop in which we found out what 'sustainability' means.



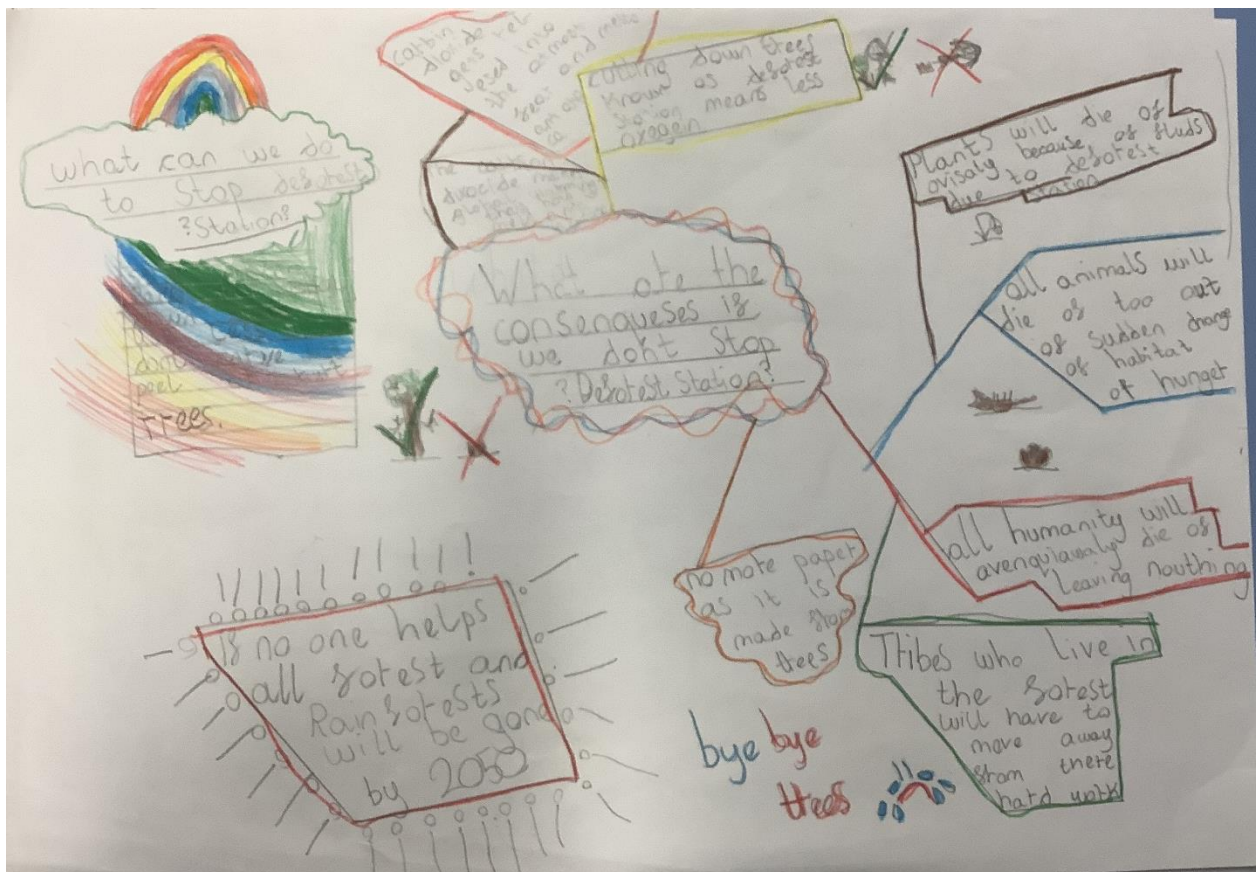
Children researched the consequences of deforestation to the wider world, global warming and carbon emissions as well as looking at
