

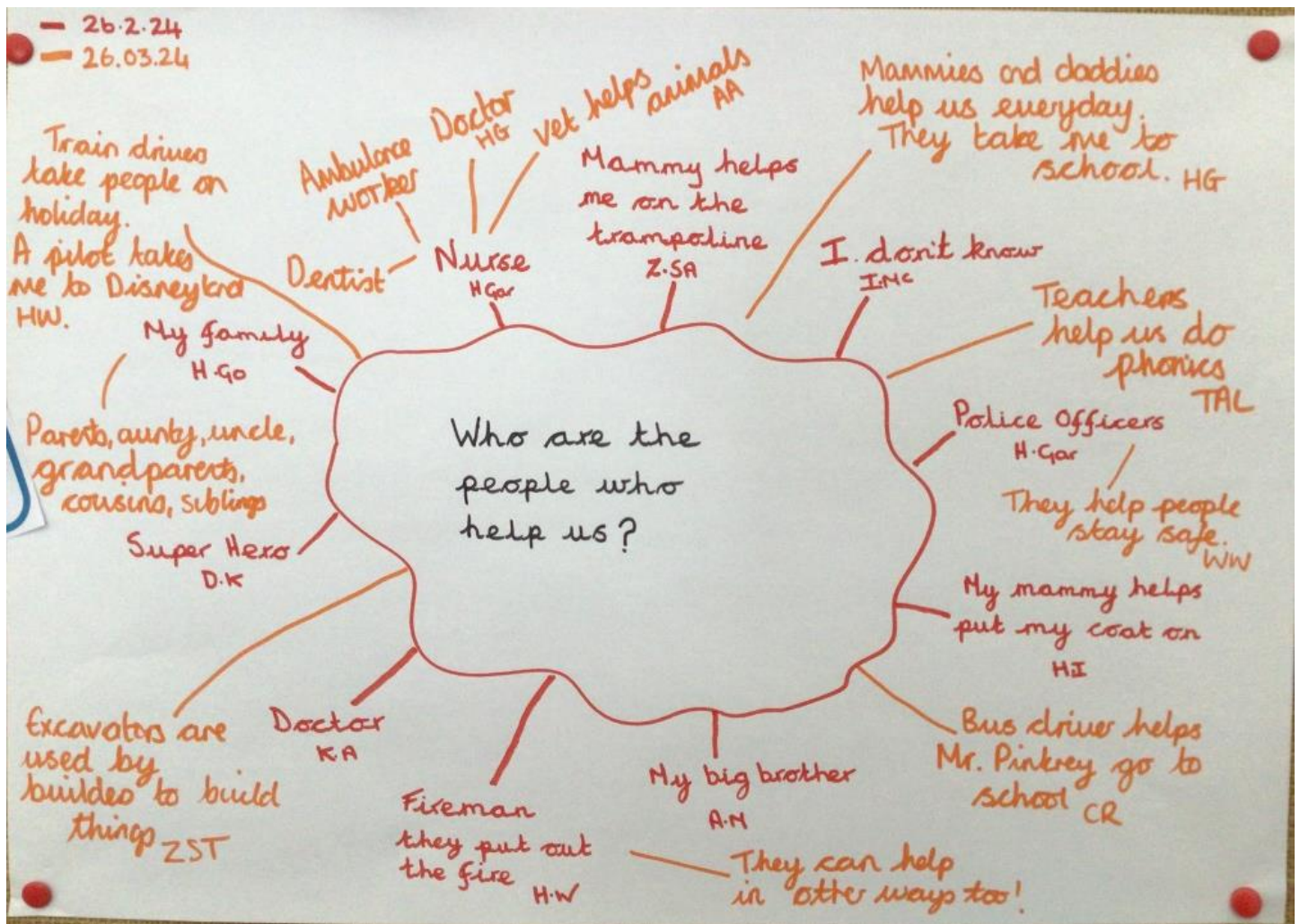


# Who are the

We began our enquiry based learning by asking the question. We recorded the children's responses which you can see below in red. You can see what the children now know in orange.



We then started our enquiry looking into travel and transport. We discussed and learned about some of the key roles in this industry.





During outdoor time we built roads and other infrastructure using materials provided such as cable reels and wooden planks. We used different construction materials to build trains and other modes of transport!

In class we used construction materials and junk modelling to make our own transport. We talked about what kind of jobs would be needed using this transport. We also used small world play to tell stories.







We discussed different transport in the air, sea and on the land. We talked about the different roles and why they were important and how they helped us. We played games and used our fine motor skills to make transport using playdough. This led us into the emergency services and the important role they play in helping us.







We began by reading a range of fiction and non-fiction books and watched videos about people who can help us during group time and also as part of our class story time so the children could choose using our voting station. We explored some of the different roles within the emergency services and learned about how they help us and help to keep us safe and well.



We performed shows using emergency service puppets and watched an interview with the fire service. We learned lots of new information.







We developed our fine motor skills matching pictures and cutting out our own people who help us to make collages. We had to talk about the jobs we cut out.



We got creative and used different multimedia to make emergency service vehicles.



Both indoors and outdoors we became firefighters and police officers. We used our imagination during role play.



Following on from emergency services we learned about some other jobs in different industries such as health, education, retail and hospitality and learned about how they help us



We become bakers, builders, teachers, parents and hairdressers. We learned that these roles are just as important and they help us in different ways.





During our computing lessons we developed our mouse skills by using a programme called 2Simple. We were mechanics, refuse collectors, builders, farmers and even vets!
