

Key Instant Recall Facts Nursery Spring 1


Spring 1:

Use the positional language: 'in front', 'behind', 'next to', 'on top' and 'under'.

Teddy is **in front of** a doll's house.

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Teddy is **behind** a tree.

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
Teddy is **under** a table.

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Teddy is **next to** a toy car.

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Teddy is **on top of** a cupboard.

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Top Tips

The secret to success? Practice little and often! Can you learn these on your way to school? On a car journey? Or even at the breakfast table? You don't need to learn them all at once: start with those you are more confident with before tackling the rest.

Things to try:

Use concrete materials- place the objects in different places and talk about where is the object?

You can use food, toys, teddy.

Ask your child to place the object - in front of ... , behind ... , next to ... , on top of ... , under ...

Share stories e.g. Hide and seek
