


What is the significance of The Newcastle Castle and Keep to the City of Newcastle?

through the ages and have been reading a class novel called, 'Walking with Witches' in English. The Castle Keep features in this novel and so our





investigation began with our enquiry based learning.


We carried out our own research on the significance of The
