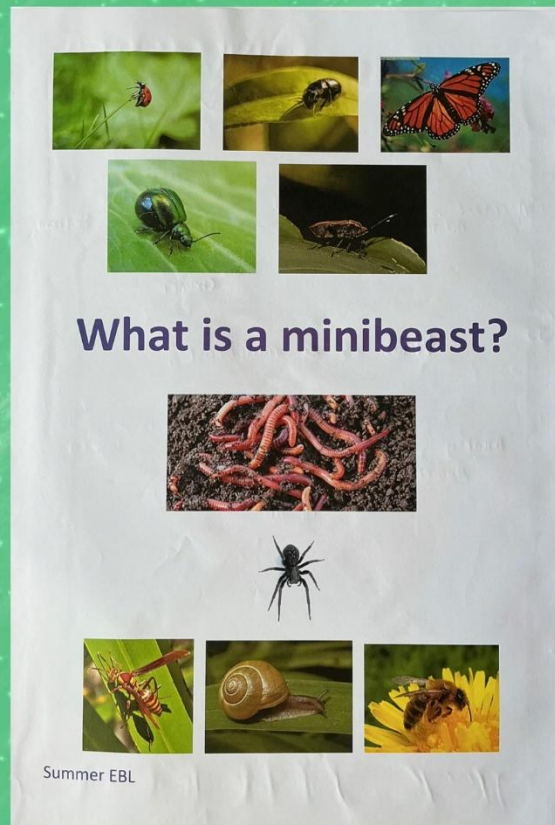
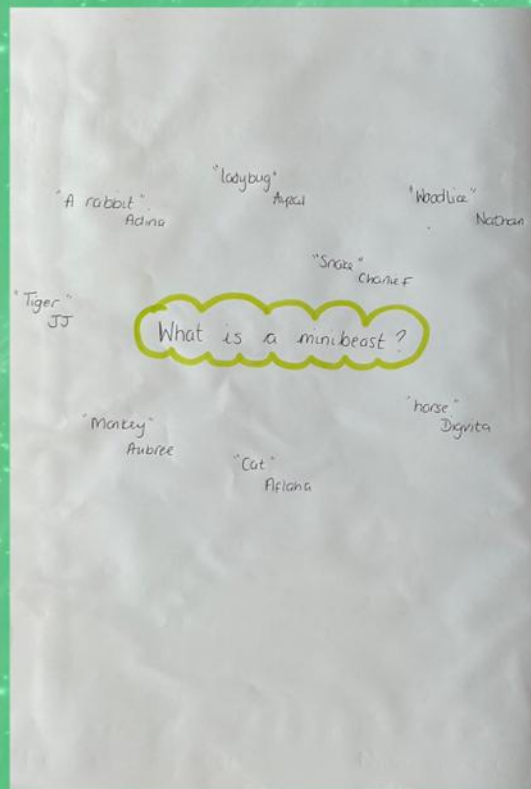


We launched our enquiry based learning with a question...

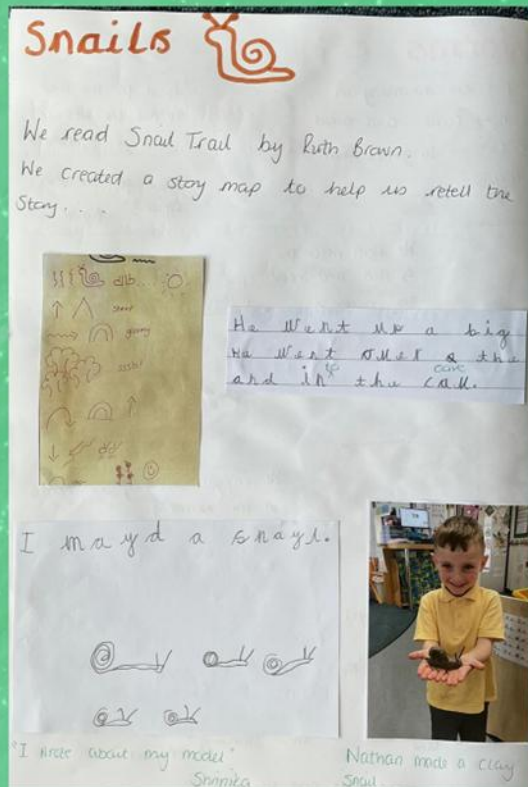
The first minibeast we explored was a worm.

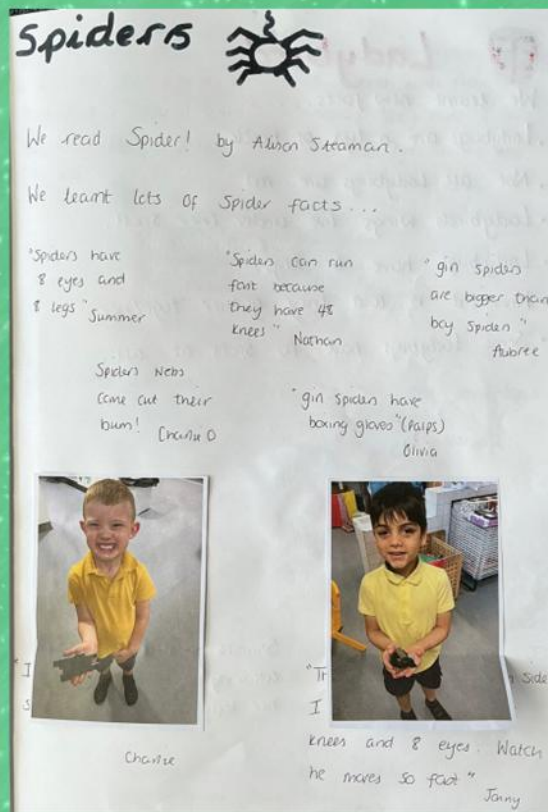
Next, we learnt about snails.

- Some Ladybugs have no spots at all.

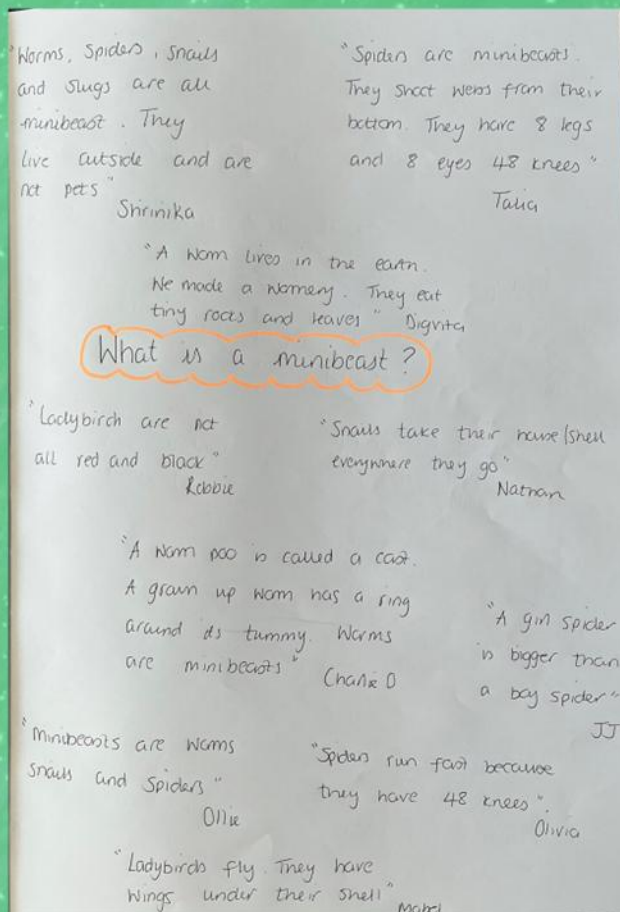


Shrinika spent time drawing, colouring and cutting out her ladybird.
