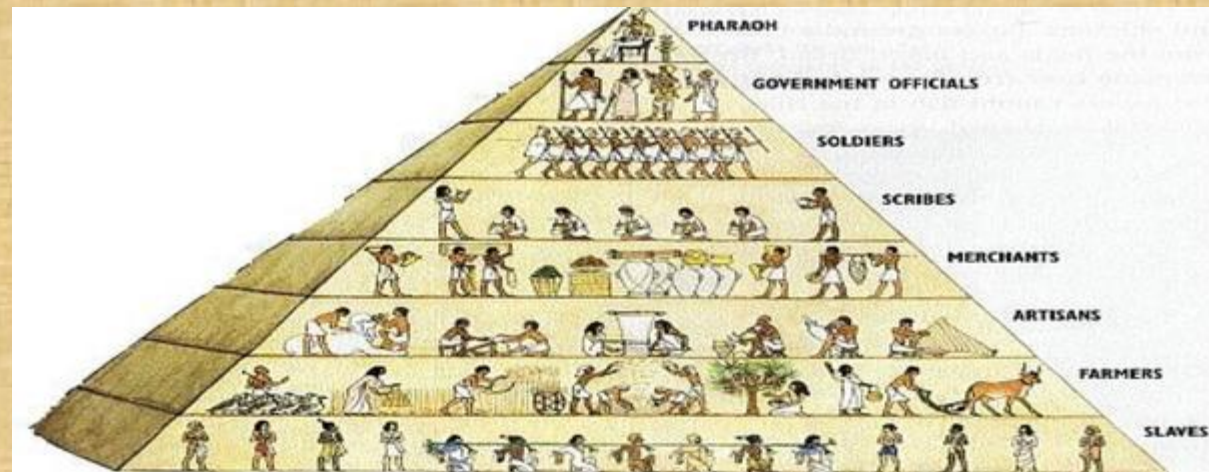
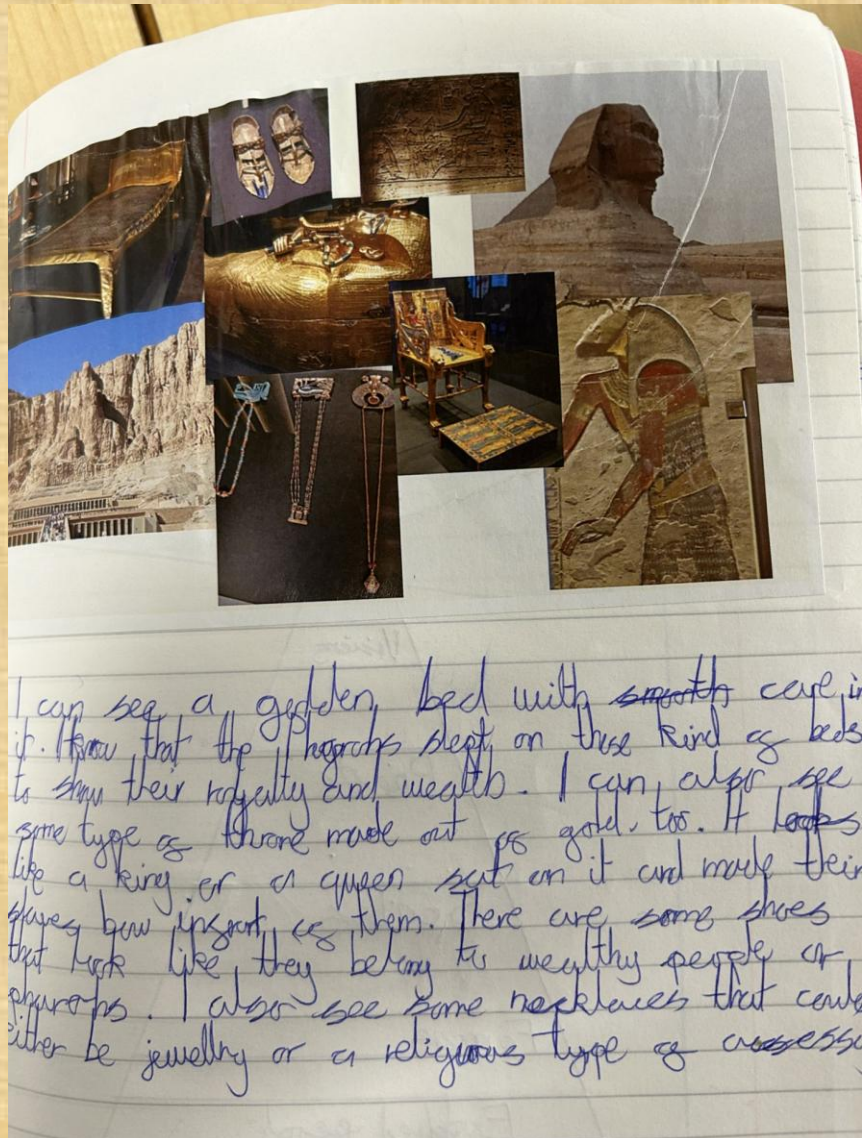


What is the greatest achievement of the Ancient Egyptians?

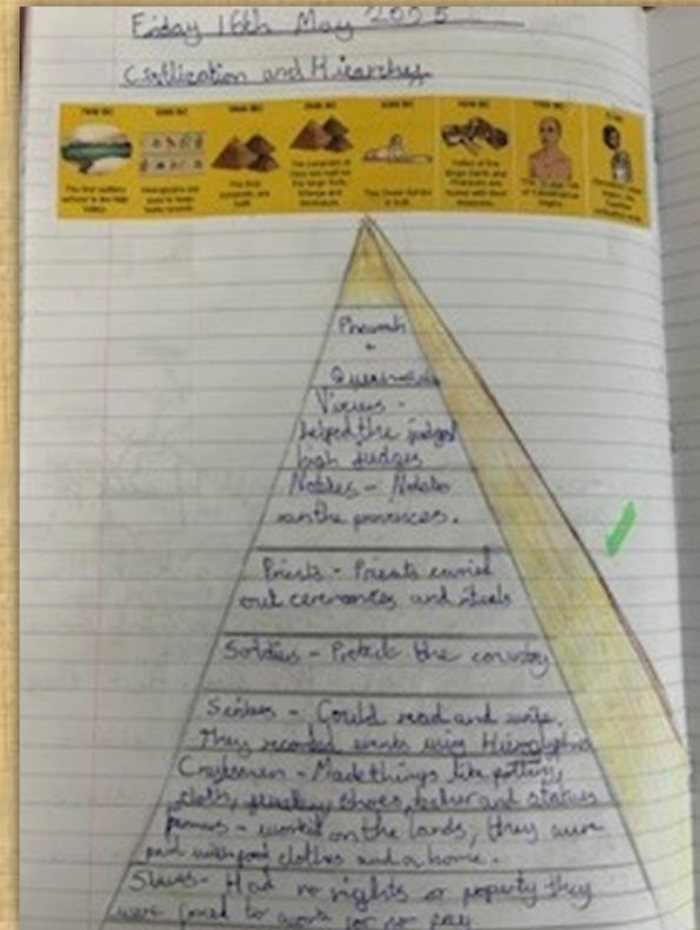
What was it used for?

How to send a pharaoh to the Afterlife

Mummification
First of all, purify the body using palm water and substance from the river Nile (they believed that this was a good of water) and they are gathered it ready to be used.

And it's time for your Pharaoh to be wrapped up into a mummy, using a bandage from the fabric linen, placing the amulets and the book of The Dead with you.

Lastly, the body has been wrapped into a mummy and is ready to be placed in the catacomb, it should be placed in the tallest pyramid. (for wealthy people).

Burial



And now the last step, burial, your pharaoh has relaxed for years, he must not in peace (dead). That's why the pharaohs most trusted slaves available avoided, imited through out this journey and will construct an outside resting place. He could be buried in the valley.

Of the Kings or a second passage way, where nobody could seek. On the burial day, a mummy will take place on his behalf. after, he would be taken into his seeling palace, his tomb also has sarcophagus to you will be getting a map from the dead. Ankhed so you can search and find the hidden room. Inside the room will be stored with his beloved possessions, you need to keep the possessions in the room to make comfortable in the after life.

How to send a pharaoh to the afterlife
When an almighty god calls upon the flames of the afterlife, follow these instructions and get him there peacefully.

1. To start of his journey, rinse of the body thoroughly with water from the Nile and palm oil. This will purify the body for the next stage.

2. For this step, use a hook to pull his brain through his nose. Make sure to use sandalwood and resin in their skull to use the egg that their brain is still there.

3. Next take the organs out the body (except the heart) after that take their liver, lungs, intestines and the stomach, put them in scaropic jars. The reason you do this is so their organs will get to the afterlife safely with the gods protection.

4. After that, make sure to cover the body with natron salt to preserve the body, then leave it to dry for 40 days to get ready for the next step.

5. After then leave 10 days, detach the salt off the body and place straw, dried grass and get the linen ready for the body, this is to start wrapping up the body.

6. To make their body look nice and attractive, use some expensive makeup, hair and fake eyes to get to the afterlife.

7. After wrapping up the body, prepare a book of the dead and place amulets on the body to prepare your pharaoh for the wrath of the gods.

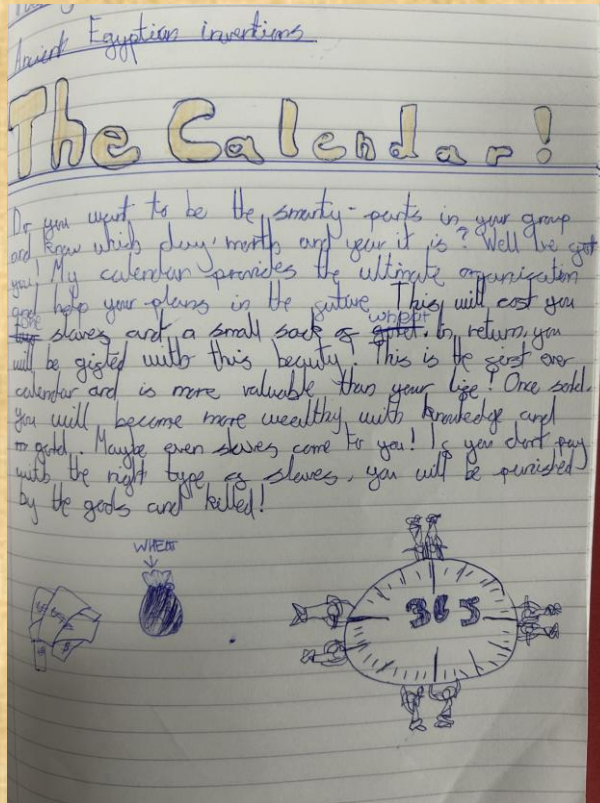
